
In 2016 the nuclear medicine technology program sponsored by Armstrong State University received continued accreditation for five (5) years from the Joint Review Committee on Educational Programs in Nuclear Medicine Technology (JRCNMT). Extension of accreditation to the full term of seven years was contingent upon submission of a progress report satisfactorily addressing a deficiency in compliance with one accreditation standard.

Based on the information provided in the program's progress report, the JRCNMT voted at its meeting on October 6-7, 2017 to extend accreditation two (2) additional years. The next evaluation of the program for continued accreditation will occur in 2023. A mid-cycle report will be due on February 1, 2020.

Notification of this decision will be forwarded to the institution's accrediting agency. The information will also be made available to the public on the JRCNMT website.

The JRCNMT extends best wishes for continued success in the operation and on-going improvement of this educational program.
