Dear Dr. Cartwright:

At its meeting on October 29, 2020, the Joint Review Committee on Educational Programs in Nuclear Medicine Technology (JRCNMT) reviewed of the self-study and letter of site visit findings for the nuclear medicine technology program at University of Missouri. The program was found to be in compliance with the *Accreditation Standards for Nuclear Medicine Technologist Education*. Accordingly, the JRCNMT voted to confer continued accreditation for seven (7) years. The program's next review for continued accreditation will occur in 2027. A mid-cycle report will be requested in 2024.

This award is made on the condition that the number of students enrolled in the clinical phase of the program shall not exceed 19. The following institutions are recognized as affiliates:


