At its meeting on October 25, 2019, the Joint Review Committee on Educational Programs in Nuclear Medicine Technology (JRCNMT), based upon its review of the self-study and letter of site visit findings, voted to confer continued accreditation for the full term of seven years to the nuclear medicine technology program at Forsyth Technical Community College.

The program's next review for continued accreditation will occur in 2026. A mid-cycle report will be requested in 2023.


This award is made on the condition that the number of students enrolled in the clinical phase of the program shall not exceed 11 students per the program's request. The following institutions are recognized as affiliates:
