At its meeting on October 25, 2019, the Joint Review Committee on Educational Programs in Nuclear Medicine Technology (JRCNMT), based upon its review of the self-study and letter of site visit findings, voted to confer continued accreditation for the full term of seven years to the nuclear medicine technology program at the University of Oklahoma Health Sciences Center.

The program's next review for continued accreditation will occur in 2026. A mid-cycle report will be requested in 2023.


