
In 2014 the nuclear medicine technology program sponsored by Community College of Allegheny County received continued accreditation for two years from the Joint Review Committee on Educational Programs in Nuclear Medicine Technology (JRCNMT). Extension of accreditation to the full term was contingent upon submission of a progress report satisfactorily addressing cited deficiencies in compliance with published accreditation standards.

Based on the information provided in the program's progress report, the JRCNMT voted on April 10, 2015 to extend accreditation four additional years. The next evaluation of the program for continued accreditation will occur in 2020. A mid-cycle report will be requested in spring 2017 that is due by August 2017.

Notification of this decision will be forwarded to the institution's accrediting agency. The information will also be made available to the public on the JRCNMT website.

The JRCNMT extends best wishes for continued success in the operation and on-going improvement of this educational program.
