Dear Dr. Nicotera:

At its meeting on October 21-22, 2016, the Joint Review Committee on Educational Programs in Nuclear Medicine Technology (JRCNMT), based upon its review of the self-study and site evaluation report, voted to award the nuclear medicine technology program at Houston Community College continued accreditation for seven (7) years.

The program's next review for continued accreditation will occur in 2023. A mid-cycle report will be requested in fall 2019 that is due by February 1, 2020.

This award is made on the condition that the number of students enrolled in the clinical phase of the program shall not exceed 46. The following institutions are recognized as affiliates:


