Dear Dr. Light:

At its meeting on November 6, 2015, the Joint Review Committee on Educational Programs in Nuclear Medicine Technology (JRCNMT), based upon its review of the self-study and site evaluation report, voted to award the nuclear medicine technology program at University of the Incarnate Word continued accreditation for seven (7) years.

The program's next review for continued accreditation will occur in 2022. A mid-cycle report will be requested in fall 2018 that is due by February 1, 2019.

This award is made on the condition that the number of students enrolled in the clinical phase of the program shall not exceed 15. The following institutions are recognized as affiliates:


