
On October 21, 2016, the nuclear medicine technology program sponsored by Marshfield Medical Center received continued accreditation for one year from the Joint Review Committee on Educational Programs in Nuclear Medicine Technology (JRCNMT). On October 6, 2017 accreditation was extended an additional four years. Extension of accreditation to the full seven-year term was contingent upon submission of a progress report satisfactorily addressing deficiencies in compliance with published accreditation standards.

The progress report submitted by the program earlier this year satisfactorily addressed the current status of the program with respect to its compliance with Standards B2.1a, E1.1c and E1.4 in the *Accreditation Standards for Nuclear Medicine Technologist Education (2011 ed)*. Accordingly, the JRCNMT accepted the report on November 2, 2018 and extended accreditation two additional years. The program's next review for continued accreditation will occur in 2023. Submission of a Mid-Cycle Report will occur in 2020.

Notification of this decision will be forwarded to the institution's accrediting agency. The information will also be made available to the public on the JRCNMT website.

The JRCNMT extends best wishes for continued success in the operation and on-going improvement of this educational program.
