

Joint Review Committee on Educational Programs in Nuclear Medicine Technology

Notice of Accreditation Actions

Fall 2014

(Revised 12/19/14)

Accrediting agencies recognized by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation are required to notify the public of accreditation decisions and the basis for such decisions. The Joint Review Committee on Educational Programs in Nuclear Medicine Technology (JRCNMT) meets this requirement by publishing a notice of accreditation actions on its website within 30 business days after each board meeting. The nuclear medicine technology community, regional and specialized accrediting agencies, and state agencies responsible for postsecondary education and radiation oversight are notified when a new notice of action is published.

At its meeting on October 17 - 18, 2014 the JRCNMT took the following actions regarding the nuclear medicine technology programs sponsored by the institutions listed below. ***Continued Accreditation** - Programs in this category have completed a self-study and on-site evaluation. The term for continued accreditation is up to seven years.*

Continued accreditation conferred to December 31, 2020

Continued accreditation conferred to December 31, 2015

Progress report on Standards A1.1, C1.2, C2.3a/C2.4/D1.6, and D1.5 is due February 1, 2015

Rowan College at Gloucester County (NJ)

Continued accreditation conferred to December 31, 2019

Progress report on Standard C2.1c is due February 1, 2015

Continued accreditation conferred to December 31, 2021

Mid-cycle report will be due February 2018

Accreditation Extended- Programs in this category have submitted an interim report demonstrating compliance has been achieved on previously cited standards, allowing extension of the previous accreditation award up to a maximum of seven years.

Initial Accreditation - Programs in this category have completed a self-study and on-site evaluation. The term for initial accreditation is up to three years.

Initial accreditation conferred to December 31, 2017
Mid-cycle report due in 2017

Probation - Programs in this category have completed a self-study and on-site evaluation and have been found in non-compliance with JRCNMT accreditation standards. The term for probation is up to two years.

Probation conferred for one year
