

Notice of Accreditation Actions

Spring 2015

Revised June 22, 2015

Accrediting agencies recognized by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation are required to notify the public of accreditation decisions and the basis for such decisions. The Joint Review Committee on Educational Programs in Nuclear Medicine Technology (JRCNMT) meets this requirement by publishing a notice of accreditation actions on its website within 30 business days after each board meeting. The nuclear medicine technology community, regional and specialized accrediting agencies, and state agencies responsible for postsecondary education and radiation oversight are notified when a new notice of action is published.

At its meeting on April 10 - 11, 2015 the JRCNMT took the following actions regarding the nuclear medicine technology programs sponsored by the institutions listed below. Continued Accreditation - Programs in this category have completed a self-study and on-site evaluation. The term for continued accreditation is up to seven years.

University of Vermont (VT)

Continued accreditation conferred to December 31, 2021

Mid-cycle report will be due August 2018

West Virginia University Hospital (WV)

Continued accreditation conferred to December 31, 2017

Progress report on standards C2.4d/C2.5 and C2.4g due February 1, 2016

Accreditation Extended- Programs in this category have submitted an interim report demonstrating compliance has been achieved on previously cited standards, allowing extension of the previous accreditation award up to a maximum of seven years.

Extension of accreditation two years through December 31, 2019
