At its meeting on October 29, 2020, the Joint Review Committee on Educational Programs in Nuclear Medicine Technology (JRCNMT), based upon its review of the self-study, letter of site visit findings and two progress reports, voted to confer continued accreditation for six (6) years to the nuclear medicine technology program at The Johns Hopkins Hospital.

The program's next review for continued accreditation will occur in 2026. A mid-cycle report will be requested in 2023.


This award is made on the condition that the number of students enrolled in the clinical phase of the program shall not exceed 14. The following institutions are recognized as affiliates of the program:
