
The nuclear medicine technology program at Chattanooga State Community College is scheduled for self-study submission and on-site evaluation in 2023. The Joint Review Committee on Educational Programs in Nuclear Medicine Technology (JRCNMT) chose to move some programs, with their approval, to a later year to achieve greater consistency in the number of programs undergoing reaccreditation annually.

The JRCNMT reviewed the accreditation history, length of service of the current program director, history of substantive changes, and the certification exam pass rate of each program scheduled for reaccreditation in 2023. Based on review of these criteria, the nuclear medicine technology program at Chattanooga State Community College was identified as a candidate for extension of accreditation. The program director was contacted earlier this year and confirmed the program's willingness to make this change.

On October 22, 2021, the JRCNMT voted to extend the program's accreditation two years. This moves the next review for continued accreditation from 2023 to 2025. Annual reports will continue to be required each summer.

Notification of this decision will be forwarded to the institution's accrediting agency. The information will also be made available to the public on the JRCNMT website. The JRCNMT extends best wishes for continued success in the operation and on-going improvement of this educational program.

At its meeting on October 21-22, 2016, the Joint Review Committee on Educational Programs in Nuclear Medicine Technology (JRCNMT), based upon its review of the self-study and site evaluation report, voted to award the nuclear medicine technology program at Chattanooga State Community College continued accreditation for seven (7) years.

The program's next review for continued accreditation will occur in 2023. A mid-cycle report will be requested in fall 2019 that is due by February 1, 2020.

This award is made on the condition that the number of students enrolled in the clinical phase of the program shall not exceed 22. The following institutions are recognized as affiliates:


