Dear Mr. Klauck:

At its meeting on October 22, 2021, the Joint Review Committee on Educational Programs in Nuclear Medicine Technology (JRCNMT) evaluated the self-study and letter of site visit findings of the nuclear medicine technology program at Froedtert Hospital. Deficiency in compliance with one standard resulted in the JRCNMT modifying the program's current status to accreditation with conditions.

The following deficiency warrants attention and resolution to achieve full compliance with the *Accreditation Standards for Nuclear Medicine Technologist Education*:

D3.3 Programs must have an Advisory Committee that includes each AES, along with any other members the program chooses to appoint...

*Advisory Committee minutes in the self-study were for weekly department meetings with only the Froedtert Hospital staff. No AES from other clinical sites outside of the main Froedtert hospital were invited. In December 2020, for the first time, AES from all clinical affiliates were invited to attend. This practice must continue in the future to maintain compliance with this standard.*

As part of the comprehensive program review, an assessment of all clinical affiliates determined that a maximum of 8 students can be accommodated in the clinical education portion of the program. The following institutions are recognized as this program's clinical affiliates:

Additionally, the program has recognized academic affiliations with Luther College, St. Cloud State University, University of Wisconsin – La Crosse and Wisconsin Lutheran College.


The JRCNMT requests a progress report be submitted no later than **August 1, 2022** documenting the manner in which the deficiency has been resolved. The extended period to submit the progress report is given so that minutes from both the 2021 and possibly the 2022 Advisory Committee meetings might be provided as evidence that the program continues to invite all affiliate education supervisors to the annual meeting.

If the JRCNMT determines at their fall 2022 meeting that the program has come into compliance with this standard, conditions will be removed and the program's accreditation will be continued through 2028. If the deficiency remains, continued accreditation may be deferred or the program may be placed on probation. With either of these actions a second progress report will be necessary.

The program remains accredited, with conditions, and this information will be made available to the public through the JRCNMT website and its publications.

The JRCNMT is confident that the program has the ability to come into full compliance with the *Standards*. If program officials require assistance in preparing the progress report they should contact the JRCNMT office.
