Dear Dr. James:

At its meeting on October 13, 2023, the Joint Review Committee on Educational Programs in Nuclear Medicine Technology (JRCNMT) voted to confer continued accreditation for seven years to the nuclear medicine technology program at Baptist Health College Little Rock. This decision was based on the fact that review of the self-study and letter of site visit findings indicated that the program is in substantial compliance with JRCNMT accreditation standards.


The program's next review for continued accreditation will occur in 2030. A mid-cycle report will be requested in 2027.

This award is made on the condition that the number of students enrolled in the clinical phase of the program shall not exceed 8. The program's recognized affiliates and their respective student capacities are identified on the page attached to this letter.

Notification of this decision will be forwarded to the institution's accrediting agency and will also be made available to the public through the JRCNMT website and its publications.

## Clinical Affiliates and Capacities

A program’s student capacity is based on equipment, staffing levels and procedure volume at each clinical affiliate, as reported in the self-study or in newer documentation provided before or at the time of the site visit. An arranged clinical capacity, noted as “arr @”, means students are assigned to the facility for a special-focus rotation of limited duration. Arranged capacities are not included in the calculation of a program’s total clinical student capacity. Where clinical affiliates are shared with other educational programs, it is the responsibility of the program directors to ensure clinical assignments do not exceed the approved capacity at these affiliates.
