Dear Dr. Steib:

In 2023, the Joint Review Committee on Educational Programs in Nuclear Medicine Technology (JRCNMT) placed the nuclear medicine technology program sponsored by Delgado Community College on “Accreditation with Conditions”. Removal of conditions and continued accreditation was contingent upon submission of a Progress Report satisfactorily addressing noted deficiencies in compliance with specific accreditation standards in the *Accreditation Standards for Nuclear Medicine Technologist Education*.

The program’s Progress Report satisfactorily demonstrated the implementation of changes that bring the program into substantial compliance with Standard C5b and D1. On April 26, 2024, the JRCNMT accepted the report, removed the conditional accreditation status and continued accreditation for five (5) years. The program must submit a Mid-Cycle Report in 2026 and its next review for continued accreditation will occur in 2029.

Notification of this accreditation action will be forwarded to the institution’s accrediting agency. The information will also be made available to the public on the JRCNMT website.

During the Program Director’s extended absence, annual assessment processes were not conducted (Standard D1). The Progress Report submitted this year contained the first complete report on assessment of student learning and program effectiveness in over two years. Though the cited deficiency in compliance with this standard was removed, the review identified issues with student learning assessment, documented on JRCNMT Form J, that require additional attention by the Program Director prior to submission of this year’s Annual Report. Feedback from the reviewers is attached to this letter.


Since thorough and appropriate assessment practices documented on Forms J and L are critical to ensuring a satisfactory Annual Report, the JRCNMT wants to support the program in making adjustments to achieve this critical goal. A Progress Report is due no later than **June 3, 2024**. The report should include a draft of Form J for the academic year ending in 2023 that incorporates the feedback from the JRCNMT reviewers provided with this letter. The report will be reviewed and additional feedback provided in July, so the program can make final

adjustments prior to submitting this year's Annual Report. Due to the need for a progress report in June and the necessary time to review it, the deadline for submission of the program's Annual Report has been extended to **August 15, 2024**.

Please contact the JRCNMT office if there are questions about the attached feedback, the Progress Report due next month or the extended Annual Report deadline.

The JRCNMT extends best wishes for continued success in the operation and on-going improvement of this educational program.
